



The Problem According to MIHI (UP data)




Can the Market Solve this Problem?


- Commercial Internet Service Providers since 1989





How to Prepare for Federal Broadband Grants

- 1. Form your coalition
- 2. Assess Current State of the Community
- 3. Engage Stakeholders in the Community
- 4. Identify community needs / coalition interests
- 5. Identify targeted grants & read fine print
- 6. Design program with targeted grant(s) in mind
- 7. Develop Cost Estimate
- 8. Narrative Development
- 9. Budget Development
- 10. Submit application



5 Things You Can Do Today To Get Started



- Download your availability data from FCC's National Broadband Map
- 2. Locate your county's data set from the 2022 Michigan broadband infrastructure audit
- 3. Put the 10/27 BEAD Map Challenge Working Group on your calendar and invite your GIS lead
