- Proposals are to be mailed to the project representative
- Outside of envelop should be clearly marked "UPA Server Bid"
- The RFP has two sections I. Server & Software Licensing and II. NetMotion Mobility software.
- Vendors may provide proposals for either or both at their discretion.
- Vendors shall provide line item pricing and a grand total for each section.
