SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Offers delivery of hot, nutritious meals to homebound elderly individuals who are unable to prepare meals for themselves.

ELIGIBILITY: - Must be 60 or older or be the spouse of a qualifying individual or be an individual with disabilities residing in household with a qualifying individual receiving home delivered meals

- Must be homebound (does not leave home under normal circumstances)
- Unable to participate in congregate program
- Unable to prepare food for self
- No adult in the same building able or willing to prepare food
- Able to feed self
- Reside in Marquette or Alger counties

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED: No documentation required

FEES: Donation of \$3.50/meal is encouraged but not required

- Physically or emotionally homebound (does not leave home under normal circumstances)

- Unable to participate in congregate program
- Unable to prepare food for self
- No adult in the same building able or willing to prepare food
- Able to feed self

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED: No documentation required

FEES: No fees, but a \$4/donation is suggested
