**SERVICE DESCRIPTION:** Site 1: Provides people who are low income or in an emergency situations with food.

Site 2: Provides people who are in emergency situations with food.

Other Sites: Provides people who are in emergency situations with vouchers that can be exchanged for clothing, furniture, bedding/linens, food pantries, appliances, and household goods.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Site 1: Individuals who meet low-income guidelines. Gross income of 200% Federal Poverty Income Guidelines.

Site 2: Individuals who meet low-income guidelines.

**DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:** Site 1: Social Security cards, date of birth and proof of income for everyone in the household.

Site 2: Social Security Card, identification, and proof of income for all individuals in household.

**FEES:** No fees
