SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Site 1: Provides food to individuals and families on a weekly basis.

Site 2: Provides people who are in emergency situations with vouchers that can be exchanged for clothing, furniture, bedding/linens, appliances, and household goods. Food pantry available for qualified individuals.

Site 3: Provides food for low income individuals and families on an emergency basis.

Site 4: Provides people who are low income or in an emergency situations with food.

Site 5: Provides people who are in emergency situations with food.

ELIGIBILITY: Site 1: Individuals who meet low-income guidelines. Gross income of 200% Federal Poverty Income Guidelines.

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Site 1: Provides approximately a month supply of food to low-income families in an emergency assistance situation. Site 2: Provides a 3-5 day supply of food to low-income families in an emergency assistance situation. Food delivery is available to those that cannot get to the office, it is case by case.

ELIGIBILITY: Site 1: - Individuals who meet income guidelines, and those that maybe considered "over" can come in for the "first" foodbox, and then talk to the Case Worker about future plans. - No one is turned away. Other Sites: Individuals who meet income guidelines

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED: Site 1: Proof of residency, proof of household income and verification of family size and pictured Identification Site 2: Proof of residence, proof of household income and verification of family size and pictured Identification

FEES: No fees
