


Participants Needed for Research Study on Hearing Aid Use in Older Adults With Dementia



WHAT IS THIS STUDY ABOUT?

Hearing loss has a negative effect on communication and quality of life, but not everyone with hearing loss uses hearing aids. We want to learn more about hearing aid use in older adults with Alzheimer's or other dementia. Our goal is to improve hearing aid design and delivery for these individuals.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

We want to hear from:

- Adults aged 65+
- Diagnosis of Alzheimer's or other dementia
- Self-perceived hearing difficulty

WHAT DOES PARTICIPATION INVOLVE?

- Participation in an approximately 30-minute Zoom interview
- Completion of a brief cognitive screening test
- Completion of brief online survey questionnaires
- A family member or friend may attend the research session to assist

WILL I BE COMPENSATED?

Participants will be compensated \$50 for participating in this study.
