**ELIGIBILITY:** Site 1: - Individuals who meet low-income guidelines - Gross income of 200% Federal Poverty Income Guidelines

**DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:** Site 1: Social Security cards, date of birth and proof of income for all family members needed to register for the food pantry.

Site 2: Proof of income and ID

Site 3: Social Security cards, date of birth and proof of income for each member of the household.

Site 4: Social Security cards, date of birth and proof of income for everyone in the household.

Other Sites: No documentation required
